# SYLLABUS OF WRITTEN TEST FOR THE POST OF SENIOR SECRETARIAT ASSISTANT

## Written Test (In English only except for Hindi language part)

## 1. Post Specific including Computer Knowledge:

60%

<u>Office procedures</u>: File Management, General Financial Rules (GFR), Fundamental Rules & Supplementary Rules (FR & SR), RTI Act, CCS Conduct Rules, Reservation and Service Rules, Leave Rules, TA/DA Rules, Departmental Promotion Committee(DPC), Pay fixation, Seniority, Goods and Services Tax(GST) Rules, Legal Matters.

UGC Regulations governing the service conditions of the teachers and other UGC regulations, AICTE regulations, etc.

<u>Computer Knowledge</u>: Components of Computer, Input and output devices, Installation of printer and other input & output devices, MS-Office, MS-Word, MS-Excel and MS-PowerPoint, Internet and internet applications, Working with email, Data security / Cyber security

### 2. Mental Ability, Reasoning & Mathematical skills:

20%

Analogy, Series Completion, Coding and Decoding, Venn Diagram, Alphabetical Test, Number ranking & Time sequence test, Data Interpretation,

Simplification, LCM & HCF, Time and Distance, Profit & Loss, Simple & Compound Interest, Time & Work, Percentages, Averages, Ratio & Proportion, Problems on Numbers & Ages, Mensuration.

### 3. English and Hindi Language Proficiency:

20%

Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc.

DOMAIN SKILL TEST FOR THE POST OF SENIOR SECRETARIAT ASSISTANT

The candidate should be able to demonstrate proficiency in:

1. Computer based Typing test for 10 minutes in English at the speed of 40 w.p.m. (8% errors / mistakes only are allowed for qualifying).

#### OR

- 2. Typing test for 10 minutes in Hindi at the speed of 30 w.p.m. (8% errors / mistakes only are allowed for qualifying).
- 3. Usage of MS-Excel.
- 4. Preparation of presentation using MS-PowerPoint.
- 5. Domain specific skills related to the post.

Note: (a) The total marks for the domain skill test = 50 (only for Item Nos. 2, 3, and 4)

(b) The Domain skill test is qualifying in nature, and candidate must score a minimum of 40% marks(only for Item Nos. 2, 3, and 4).
