ITEM NO.F.27.3.1

TO CONSIDER PAYMENT OF SITTING FEE @ Rs.3000/- PER MEETING BESIDES PAYMENT OF TA/DA TO THE MEMBERS OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL, FINANCE COMMITTEE, BOARD OF GOVERNORS, NITTTR CHANDIGARH SOCIETY AND SELECTION COMMITTEE FOR ATTENDING INSTITUTE MEETINGS

The Finance committee recommended to the Board of Governors to approve the proposal of the institute regarding enhancement of sitting fee / honorarium to Rs.3000/- per sitting to the Chairman and members of the board, NITTTR Chandigarh Society, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Selection committee as per the provision in other NITTTRs.

ITEM NO.F.27.3.2 TO CONSIDER DECLARATION OF GOODS INCLUDING EQUIPMENT, FURNITURE ETC. AS OBSOLETE OR UNSERVICEABLE

The Finance committee recommended to the Board of Governors that the items spanning more than ten years and those spanning less than ten years but costing less than Rs.10000/- be declared as obsolete or unserviceable. However, for items spanning less than ten years and costing more than Rs. 10,000/- a separate committee may examine these cases before submitting the same for the approval of Board of Governors.

TO CONSIDER THE ENHANCEMENT OF THE LEGAL FEE OF THE INSTITUTE COUNSELS

Finance Committee after detailed deliberations advised the institute to adopt the rates for legal fee as under:

- High Court Cases Rs, 14,000/- plus Rs.1,000/- as clerkage and contingent expenses.
- District Court Cases: Rs. 7,000/- plus Rs. 500/- as clerkage and contingent expenses

The committee recommended these rates to the Board of Governors for approval.

TO CONSIDER ENHANCEMENT OF MONTHLY REMUNERATION OF DR PAWAN KUMAR KANSAL, INSTITUTE PART-TIME MEDICAL OFFICER AND APPOINTMENT OF ADDITIONAL PART-TIME MEDICAL DOCTOR IN THE GIRLS HOSTELS

The Finance Committee recommended the enhancement of monthly remuneration to Dr. Pawan Kumar Kansal from Rs, 15,000/- to Rs. 20,000/- and for part Time Dispensary Attendant, from Rs.3,000/- to Rs.4,000/- per month for approval of the Board of Governors. He should stay for 2 hours instead of 1½ hours.

While agreeing with the proposal of the institute, the Finance Committee after detailed deliberations advised the institute to make out a case incorporating the recommendations of the Staff Restructuring Committee and send the same to MHRD, Govt. of India, for approval.

TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE REQUIREMENT OF AC STAFF BUS AND CAR AGAINST OLD AMBASSADOR AS WELL AS ESTEEM CAR

The Finance Committee suggested the institute to condemn the old cars (2 Nos.) as per the prescribed procedure and thereafter, apply to the Ministry for approval for purchase of new vehicles as replacement.
