Member-Secretary and Director of NITTTR, Chandigarh Prof SS Pattnaik seeked the permission from the Chairman to initiate the proceedings of the 39th meeting of Board of Governors [BOGs]. The following agenda items were considered, discussed and decision were taken as listed below:

ITEM NO. B.39.0:

WELCOMING OF THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS

The Member-Secretary and Director of the Institute Prof SS Pattnaik welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman and esteemed Members of the Board of Governors and expressed his gratitude to the Chairman and Members for sparing their valuable time and making themselves available for the 39th meeting of the Board of Governors.

ITEM NO. B.39.1:

TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE 37TH AND 38TH MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS HELD ON 03.03.2017 AND 04.08.2017 RESPECTIVELY

The minutes of the 37th and 38th meetings of the BOGs were considered and confirmed by the Hon'ble Members baring the item No. F.34.2.8 for which there was an observation from the Ministry of Human Resource Development [MHRD], Govt of India. It was observed that the decision to re-imburse the TA/DA to Prof MP Poonia (Ex-Director of the institute) for his visit to Taiwan was taken in the 34th meeting of Finance Committee which was agreed to by all Members. Prof MP Poonia initially did not claim any finance from the institute expecting the same from the Taipei Economic and Cultural Centre in India. When he did not receive the same, he got the same re-imbursed from the IRG of the Institute with due approval of the Hob'ble Chairman BOGs & Finance Committee. Realizing the need for such visit in the academic interest of the institute, the Board advised the institute to make a fresh request with details to the Ministry for consideration and to regularise the matter.

The Board took note of the observation of the Ministry conveyed vide letter No. F.No 7-3/2017-TS.IV dated 25.04.2017. After deliberations, the institute was advised to constitute a Committee to go through the detail process and procedures adopted against this recruitment. Based on the findings of the

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Committee, the institute will make a request to the Ministry to clear the selection process of Associate Professors of various departments conducted against Advertisement No. 97/2015 for which there is no ambiguity and no flouting of procedures and norms. The Board further decided to release the advertisement for the vacant posts of Associate Professors only after getting a reply to the request to be made by the institute to Ministry as advised above.

The institute downgraded the positions of Professors to Assistant Professors and released the advertisement to fill up the positions. The decision to downgrade the position of Professor was taken in the 31st meeting of BOGs vide Item No. B.31.5.14 which was held on 07.11.2014. Based on the agreed decision of the BOGs, the interviews were held. However, when the minutes were communicated, the MHRD, vide letter No. F. No.7-1/2016/TS.IV/332/16 dated 8.8.2016 made an observation and advised the institute to initiate recruitment process afresh as per sanctioned posts and as per AICTE norms. It is on record that the decision to downgrade the above positions was approved by the BOGs in its meeting held on 7.11.2014. Now, the ministry has advised the institute to initiate a fresh procedure, hence, complying with the Ministry observations, BOGs advised the Director to float advertisement for the posts of Professor immediately and initiate recruitment process as per the AICTE norms as has been advised by the Ministry.

 - (iv) Nominee of the Vice-Chancellor of the affiliated University
 - (v) Nominee of the Ministry representing SC/ST/OBC/Minority/ Women/Differently abled category
