#### **Academic Achievements of the Departments**

Besides this, 23945 participants were trained through MOOCs/ NITTT Modules.
- 11 MOUs signed in this period with various Institutes and Industries like IIIT Una, MNIT Japur and IBM etc.
- NITTTTR, Chandigarh received LoI as Awarding Body (Dual) from NCVET, New Delhi for Creditization of Training Programmes. One NOS on Fundamentals of Data Science and Machine Learning has been submitted for approval.
- Institute jointly organized a 05 days Innovation, Design and Entrepreneurship (IDE) Bootcamp from 22nd - 26th June 2023 with AICTE and MIC under Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan.
- An International Regional Programme on “Industry Academia Integration and Sustainable Entrepreneurship” was organized in collaboration with CPSC Manila from 4th to 8th September, 2023 to increase the international collaboration.
- Dr. Subhas Sarkar, Hon’ble Union Minister of State for Education, Govt. of India visited the Institute on

5th October, 2023.

- 15th Tribal Youth Exchange Programme was held from 10th to 16th October, 2023 in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra, Chandigarh. 220 tribal students from Orissa, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and Jharkhand attended the programme.
- Mr. Shaurya Doval, Director, India Foundation, delivered a thought- provoking talk on “India’s Vision 2047: Economic Achievements and the Role of NEP 2020” on 28th July 2023, which was attended by all faculty, staff and students of the Institute.
- A NSDC International Skill Centre was established in which 32 nurses from all over India have been trained by 04 German faculty and have gone to Germany.
- NITTTR Chandigarh, redesigned website by the technical staff of Computer Science and Engineering Department.
- Prof. V.G. Talawar, Hon’ble Chairman, BoG and visited the campus on 30.10.2023.
- The Institute organized the 14th Inter NITTTR Sports Meet from 20th - 23rd February, 2024. NITTTR, Chandigarh won the Overall trophy in the Inter-NITTTR Sports Meet.
- One-day symposium on “Emerging Avenues for Indian MSMEs and Business Start-ups in-line with NEP” on 1st December, 2023 was conducted.
- Under the mission mode recruitment, 45 new recruitees joined NITTTR on different posts.
- The institute launched 4 new MOOCs and rerun 5 MOOCs in SWAYAM Portal
- The institute organized one International Conference and two National Conferences during this year
- Total 71 students in ME Regular and Modular in various branches.
- Faculty published 145 SCI Papers and 65 in Non SCI Journals and 10 in National Journals. Faculty also published 40 papers in Proceedings in International Conferences and 11 in National Conferences.

## 2.1 Staff Development

The institute continued to grow in terms of academic activities, both qualitatively and quantitatively. The qualitative dimensions covered related to continued improvements by way of increased emphasis on applications, case studies and industrial exposure in training programs besides more efficient and effective use of e-contents, videos, in teaching-learning process. University, Shimla for Ph.D. Program as on March 2024, 53 students are undergoing Ph.D. programs in different disciplines. The Institute is also the coordinator of Ph.D. QIP (Poly) Scheme of AICTE.

The Institute offers full-time industry-oriented and practice-based Master's Degree Programs of 02 years' duration affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh and approved by AICTE in the following disciplines:

The Faculty Development Programmes were broadly of 5 categories viz: industry oriented, industry supported, research oriented, skill oriented and advanced level. The Institute offers need-based and customized short-term courses of one to two weeks' duration for faculty/staff of engineering colleges, polytechnics and working professionals from industry. During the year 2023-24, 353 short-term programs were conducted through contact and ICT mode for faculty/staff of engineering colleges and polytechnics which were attended by 31595 teachers from various states of the country. ## 2.2 Curriculum Development

The institute continued to undertake curriculum development activities including the design and review of curricula for courses in engineering and non-engineering areas through a scientific approach, which has been considerably internalised by the polytechnic system enabling them to take up similar projects by themselves with some guidance from this institute. During the year 2023-24, 24 curricula have been designed for PSBTE. The department conducted 38 Curriculum Development Workshops of 1-2 days’ duration which were attended by 281 participants.

During the year 2023-24, During the year 2032-24, institute continued its efforts to promote development of instructional material, both print (text books, laboratory manuals, modules, readers etc.) and non-print (video programme, MOOCs videos). The institute developed 115 Video films and 175 video films are edited and uploaded in Youtube channel

During the year 2023-24, 09 Ph.D. and 70 ME thesis were completed under the guidance of institute faculty. 10 Patents have been Published/Granted by the Institute faculty.
