INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. **TEST WILL BE CONDUCTED AT CHANDIGARH ONLY. ALLOCATED OF CENTER ADDRESS WILL BE PRINTED ON CANDIADTE ADMIT CARD.**
2. E-Admit Card for qualifying test for the post of Assistant Professor, scheduled for Wednesday 7th June 2023, will be available for download from Thursday, **the 3rd June 2023 after 11 AM**, from NITTTR Chandigarh website (www.nitttrchd.ac.in).
3. Please note that only the original printout of E-Admit Card with properly identifiable details including a clear printout of uploaded photograph is considered valid. Photocopies or improperly printed (too light or too dark) E-Admit cards are not acceptable.
4. Candidates are advised to carry only the following items into the examination venue :
(a) E-Admit Card along with self-attested additional photograph (not more than three months old) pasted on the E-Admit card (b) Duly filled in Self Declaration Undertaking (c) and Personal transparent water bottle.
5. Candidates must carry “Any **ONE** of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government” – Driving License / Voter ID card / Passport / PAN card / Aadhaar Card (original print out with clear image of the face). All other ID / Photocopies of IDs even if attested / scanned photo of IDs in mobile phone will **NOT** be considered as valid ID Proof.
6. **For Morning session**, entry to the examination centre will start at **9.45 AM** and will close **exactly at 10.15 AM (15 minutes before the start of examination)**. **No entry of the candidates will be allowed after 10.15 AM.**
7. **For Evening session**, entry to the examination centre will start at **01.45 PM** and will close **exactly at 02.15 PM (15 minutes before the start of examination)**. **No entry of the candidates will be allowed after 02.15 PM.**
8. Early exit from the examination centre will **NOT** be permitted.
9. **Digital photograph and thumb impression of the candidates shall be captured at the examination centre.**
10. Candidates are expected to maintain the dignity and sanctity of the examination by being disciplined at the exam centre.
11. Candidates will **NOT** be allowed to wear / take the following items inside the examination centre under any circumstances :
 - a. Any stationery item like textual material (printed or written), notes, Plastic Pouch, Calculator, Writing Pad / Pen, Pen Drives, Eraser, etc.
 - b. Any electronic device like Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Wrist Watch / Health Band, Calculator, Electronic Pen / Scanner, etc.
 - c. All ornaments like bracelets, Ring, Earrings, Nose-pin, Chain / Necklace, Pendants, Necklace with pendants, Badge, Brooch, etc.
 - d. Other items like Wallet, Goggles, Handbags, Belt, Cap etc.

- e. Any eatable item opened or packed, soft drinks, etc.
- f. Any other item which could be used for unfair means, for hiding communication devices like wireless / Bluetooth device, spy camera, etc.
- g. Large buttons on clothes worn by the candidate
- h. Shoes / footwear with thick soles and garments with large buttons.

No arrangement will be made at the examination centers for keeping any articles / items belonging to the candidates. If you are found in possession of electronic items, gadgets, communicative devices or any of the items as indicated above, you will be liable for action as deemed appropriate by Examination Conducting Authority including but not limited to cancellation of the candidature.

12. Frisking at the examination venues will be carried out by the police / security personnel. Candidates reach the examination centre well in time.
13. Admission of the candidates to the Examination is strictly "Provisional".
14. The mere fact that an E-Admit Card has been issued does not imply that the entries made in the application for the Examination have been accepted by the NITTTR Chandigarh as true and correct.
15. The PwD candidate must bring "PwD certificate" issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming relaxation under PwD category. The candidate must also bring her / his Own Scribe, if permissible as per Government rules. The scribe must also carry his / her own Self Declaration (Undertaking) regarding educational qualification, passport size photograph, valid government identity.
16. NITTTR Chandigarh will take up the verification of eligibility conditions for the candidates i.e. age, educational qualifications, community, etc. with reference to original documents for the candidates shortlisted on the basis of the qualifying test.
17. If, subsequent to the issue of E-Admit Card, ineligibility is detected at any stage before or after the Examination or if the conditions prescribed in the rules and instructions given in the advertisement or any other additional information / documents called for at any stage, are not complied within the time specified therein, your candidature would be rejected.
18. The candidates must note that filling of relevant columns and darkening of corresponding bubbles in the OMR answer sheet is **mandatory**. Non-filling of these may lead to non-evaluation of OMR answer sheet.
20. The examination will be of 2 hours duration, **from 10.30 AM to 12.30 PM**, for Assistant Professor in Electrical Engineering and Electronics and Communication Engineering and **2.30 pm to 4.30 pm** for Assistant Professor in Education and Educational Management.
21. Question paper will be in **English** only.
22. There will be *four* alternatives for the answers to every question.
23. The candidate will have to select only one of the four alternatives as correct answer. More than one answer or answer rubbed or covered with white fluid will not be evaluated.

24. There is **NEGATIVE** marking of the question paper and for each wrong answer, one fourth (0.25) of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.
25. If answer to any question is left blank i.e. no answer is given by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.
26. Use of calculator is not permitted in the examination hall.
27. Rough work can be done on the space provided in the question paper only.
28. Candidates have to handover the lower portion of the E-Admit card, Self-Declaration Certificate and OMR answer sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall.
29. Impersonation (to assume the identity of another with intent to deceive) is forbidden and punishable.
30. Candidates must not, on any pretext whatsoever speak to nor have any communication with any other candidate. Such communication will be regarded as a breach of the Examination Rules.
31. Unruly or any behaviour capable of disturbing or disrupting the examination shall be considered to constitute unfair practice.
32. The examination centers are under surveillance of CCTV and equipped with Jammers.
33. Candidate found to be indulging in any unfair practice, will be liable to be debarred from this and future Examinations of NITTTR Chandigarh and action may be initiated against you.
34. After the completion of your Examination paper, you must remain seated quietly and must not communicate with any other candidate till the Examination is over and you are directed to leave the examination room / hall by the invigilator.
35. Candidates will not be permitted to leave the Examination Hall till expiry of the allotted time.
36. Candidates will not be allowed to go out of the examination hall, not even for going to the toilet during the Examination time.
37. Candidates are advised to check updates on the NITTTR Chandigarh website regularly. They should also check their mailbox on the registered E-mail address and SMS in their registered Mobile No. for latest updates and information.
38. Candidates will furnish correct information as may be required from you in the Examination Hall by the Invigilator / Supervisor / other persons so authorized.

NOTE : Common reasons for being denied entry are reaching late after the start of the examination and not carrying proper E-Admit card and original IDs.
