II. SERVICE CONDITIONS

Pay and other allowance as applicable to faculty members will be admissible as sanctioned by the Government of India from time to time. Leave Travel Concession and Medical facilities are also admissible as per the rules of the Institute in force/amended from time to time.

Application Fee: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application fee: Rs.1000/- .(Non-refundable) • Candidate applying for more than one post will have to apply separately for each post and pay the application fee for each post. • No fee is required for SC/ST/Persons with Disabilities, women candidates. • Applications without fee will be summarily rejected.

4.	The eligibility of applicants will be determined with reference to the last date of receipt of applications.
5.	Candidates have to apply online ONLY. Candidate should take a printout of the filled application and keep it for record.
6.	Director, NITTTR, Chandigarh reserves the right to either fill up all the posts or some of the posts or none of them without assigning any reason.
7.	Director, NITTTR Chandigarh reserves the right to cancel the whole process without assigning or clarifying any reason.
8.	Applicants should apply online till 17 th September, 2021 and link for applying ONLINE will be closed at 5 pm on 17.9.2021.

10.	There is no need to submit any certificate in original along with the application. The Institute does not take responsibility for returning any certificate. You will be required to bring your original certificates, in case, you are called for interview/document verification.
11.	If a candidate is found to have furnished any particulars which are false or to have suppressed information, will be disqualified, and if appointed will be liable to dismissal.
12.	Appearing in a written test or interview does not guarantee employment offer
13.	<p>The institute reserves the right to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cancel the advertisement without any prior notice without any reason. Either fill up all the posts or some of the posts or none of them without assigning any reason. Not to issue appointment letter to the selected candidate(s) Cancel the process of recruitment at any stage without assigning or clarifying any reason. <p>The decision of the institute would be final.</p>
14.	No correspondence will be entertained from the applicant either before or after the selection process.
15.	Canvassing in any form will disqualify the applicant.
16.	No conditional clause by the candidate is accepted during any stage of the selection process.
17.	The institute reserves the right not to provide any information to any body on this whole process including appointment.
18.	Once submitted, not further change to submitted application is acceptable
19.	Candidates above 65 years are not eligible.

Selection Process:	
1.	Selection to these posts will be made on basis of personal interview by duly constituted selection board.
2.	Institute will conduct written test for each post separately to screen/ prioritise the applicant to be called for interview.
3.	All the applicants, irrespective of the fulfilment of qualification will be allowed to take the written test. It is in the interest of the candidates that they should satisfy themselves regarding the eligibility requirements before applying for any of the posts advertised.
4.	All the applicants will be required to appear for written test to be conducted for each post. The minimum qualifying score in the written test is 60%.
5.	There will be 100 questions and duration is 120 minutes
6.	The syllabus for written test is given on the institute website.
7.	Only candidates who qualify the written test will be called for interview/document verification based on the merit list of the written test. For each post, 30 candidates will be invited for interview entirely based on the merit in the written test for that post. However, if the number of candidates qualified in the written test are less than 30 then all qualified candidates will be called for interview.
8.	Any candidate who fails to appear for the written test, interview/document verification, if any, if called upon by the Institute to do so, will not be considered for appointment and no further correspondence shall be permitted.
9.	Interim enquiries about the result will not be entertained.
10.	No correspondence will be entertained from the applicant either before or after the selection. The decision of the institute would be final.
11.	The proof of education, qualification, age, experience and reservation claimed etc. will be verified at the time of interview/document verification.
12.	No request for change of date would be acceptable.
13.	Written test will be of qualifying in nature and the marks obtained in written test will not be counted for final selection process.
14.	<p>Final merit will be prepared based on interview, career marks, experience, etc. as stated below:</p> <p>Merit Criteria</p> <p>(A) Selection will be made in two stages:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A written test (Multiple Choice Questions based) will be conducted to screen the candidates to be called for interview. A candidate must obtain minimum 60 % marks in the written test to be eligible for being called for interview. 30 candidates will be called for interview for each post, based on the merit list prepared on the basis of written test. However, if the candidates who qualify the test are less than 30, the candidates to be called for interview will be limited to only those who qualify the written test. Written test will be of qualifying in nature and the marks obtained in the written test will not be counted towards final selection purposes.

2. Short listed candidates, based on the written test, will be called for personal interview. The final selection will be based on the personal interview on the basis of the following criteria:
